BRUSSELS BEER CHALLENGE 2017

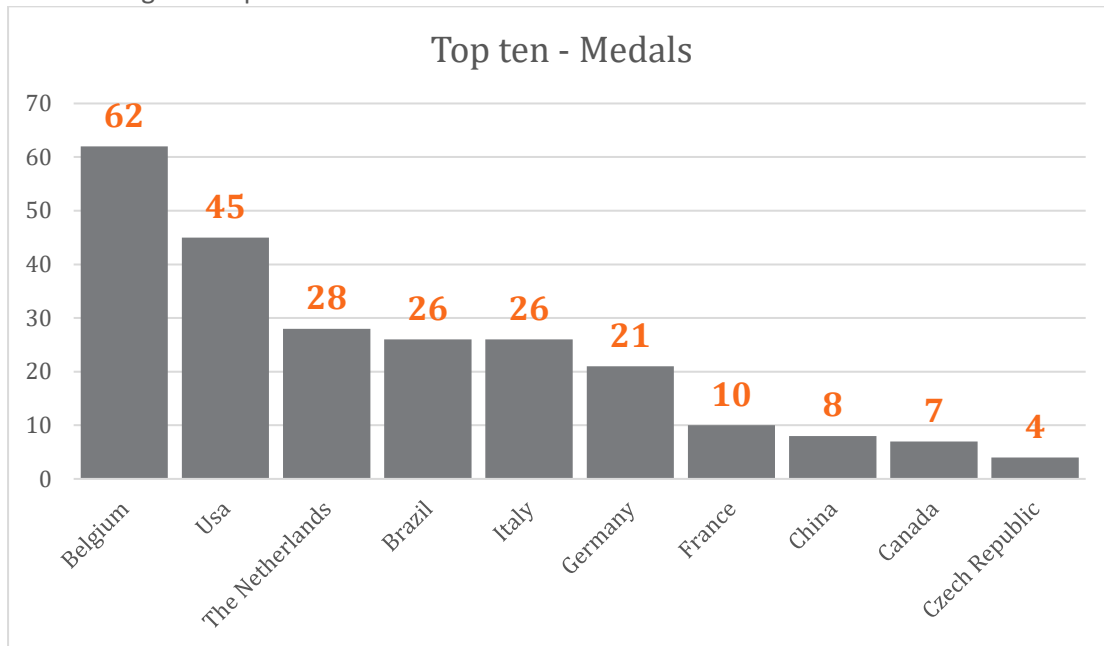

The Brussels Challenge results are a reflection of this reality.

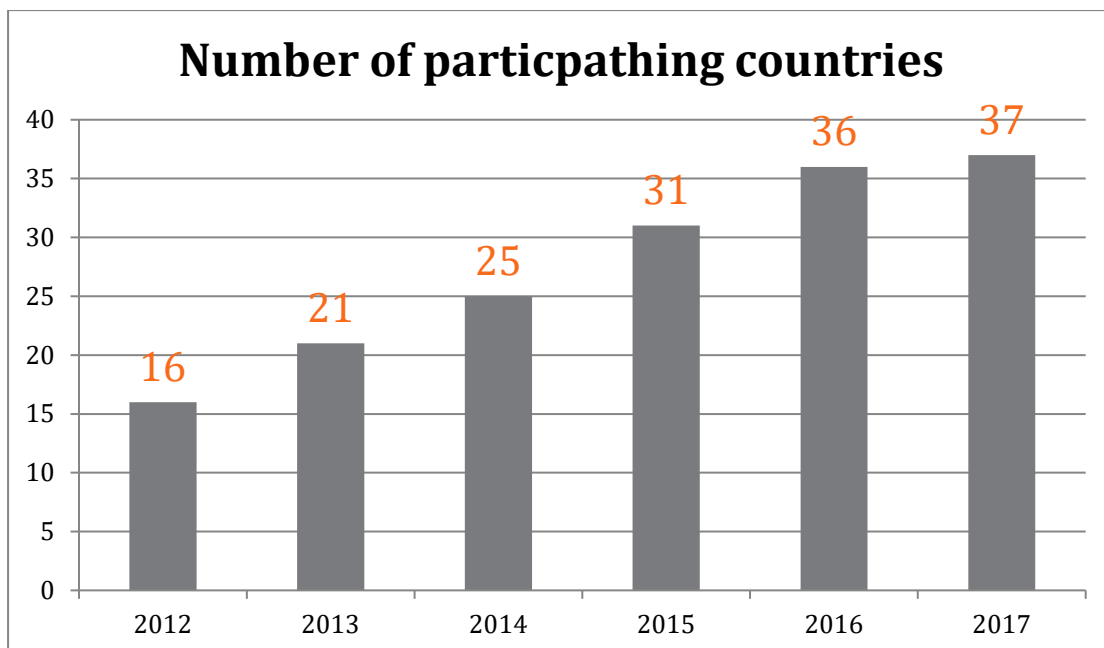


Brussels Beer Challenge 2017 Trends

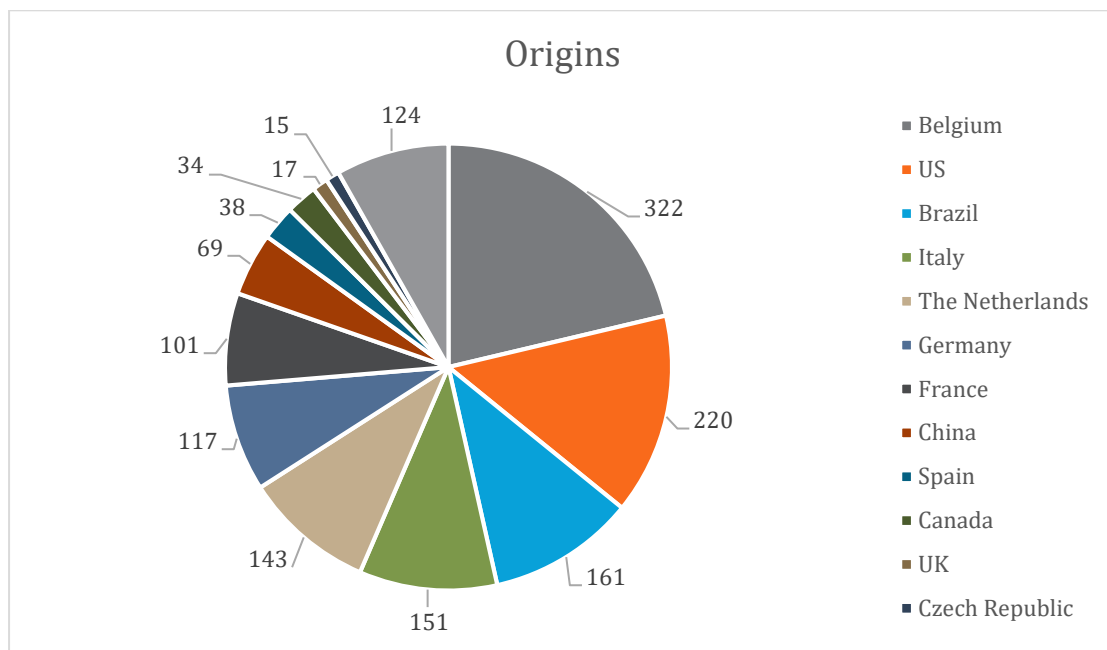
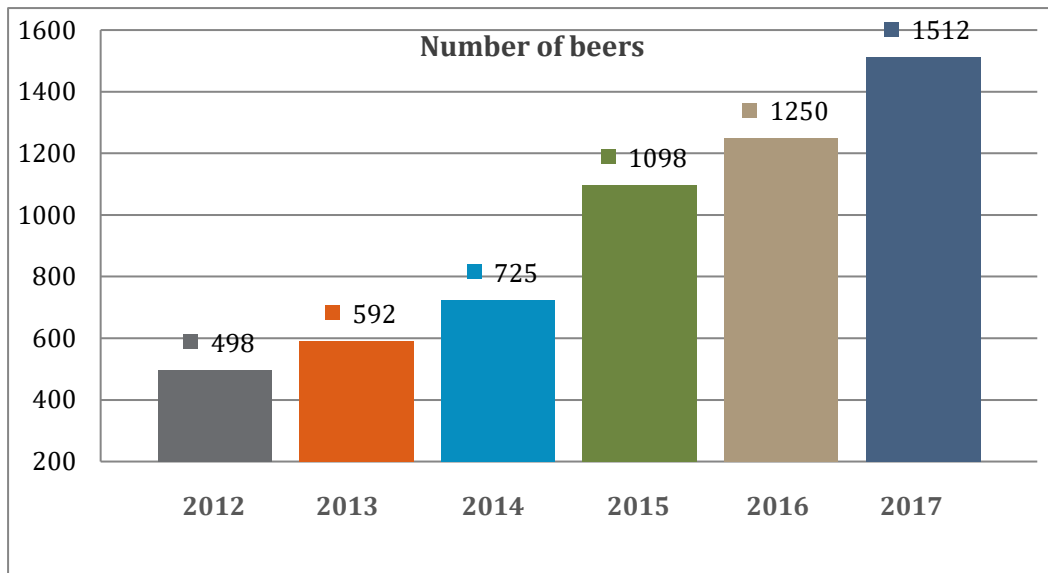
Namur is the ideal host city for celebrating the sixth Brussels Beer Challenge
